Spain 2016, 22 min

The story of the life and oeuvre of Spanish master photographer Isabel Muñoz.

What Remains of Paradise

Germany/Spain 2016, 18 min

The story of everyday life in a commune, situated between utopia and reality, told through diary recordings and Super 8 film.

Emptiness Attraction

Belgium 2016, 24 min

The story of a woman's disconnect with the world, and its familiar and indefinable sentiment.

Maternal Histories

Switzerland/Brazil 2015, 28 min

The story of the various shades of maternal instinct and the implicit inheritance that passes down from generation to generation.
